- 61.2 A planning application was read and noted for the following
- 61.2a 11 Ash Street CF39 8UE. Construction of a two-storey flat roof extension to rear of the property.
- 61.3 Correspondence was read and noted from the Mynydd Y Gaer Action Group.
- 61.4 Quotations were received for the safe removal of asbestos, that was identified on the report provided by Anchem, from the council office Etna Terrace prior to its demolition. Quotations were received from D. Davies £1500, PAR Asbestos & Environmental Services £2350 and RDM Environmental Ltd £3850. It was RESOLVED that the work be given to PAR for value for money and expertise in this field. D. Davies was the cheapest but could only provide an estimated cost.
- 61.5 Quotations were received for the demolition and removal of the council office building Etna Terrace. Once this has taken place it was RESOLVED: that it be replaced with a Community Garden. The clerk having declared a pecuniary interest left the room and took no part in the discussion. Quotations were received from B. Walters & Son £5500, Leigh Bartholomew £6200 and D.Davies £7700. It was RESOLVED: that the work be given to B. Walters & Son for value for money and the quality of workmanship of previous works undertaken.

- 62.3 Councillor Rees reported that the 172 bus service can sometimes be stationery for a prolonged period at the bus stop opposite Ffordd Llanbad. Councillor Abbott explained that there are 2 designated bus stops in the village, the one concerned and the one at Cwm Gwyrdd Medical Centre where this service is required to remain stationary if running ahead of time.
